Church Planting Missionaries in Lima, Peru



What a busy few months we have had here in Lima! Mosaico has had many firsts so far this year. We have had two weddings, several big birthday celebrations as well as our big Easter Sunday Beach baptism. Wedding celebrations are some of my favorite! Please pray for Edwin and Jordan as well as Chris and Paola as they are getting settled into their new lives as married couples. We believe that strong churches are built by strong families and we are trusting God to build these new family units unto strong pillars of the church. Will you join us in praying for them and their new marriages?

One of the communities that we work with here in Lima is the Shipivo native tribe. We heard of a Shipivo man named Pablo that was in need a wheelchair in a small local church in the jungle. Alongside a small jungle church, we were able to take Pablo a much-needed wheelchair as well as learn about the needs of their communities along the river. We would love to be able to provide the entire community with audible bibles in Shipivo. Can you help us buy as many audible bibles as possible? Each audible bible USB will cost \$30 that would provide the bible to these tribes in their native language. Message us for more info!



We also had the opportunity to serve alongside a fellow missionary in Honduras last month. There have been opportunities for us to come alongside several ministries and offer support and consulting on a few upcoming projects. We are honored to be able to play a role in the expanding of the kingdom in throughout Latin America. The lessons we have learned over the last 6 years as full-time missionaries are proving valuable as we explore a future expansion of The ONE: Collective. During our trip where we were able to give 100 kids backpacks and 135 sets of reusable dish-ware to a local church that feeds 100+ kids every Friday.

While in Honduras, we met a young man named Daniel who had been shot a few years ago. We were evaluating him for a new wheelchair but while talking with him we noticed that he had recovered most of his mobility but he didn't have the funding to continue therapy. I was lead to commit to cover his therapy for as long as he was willing to attend. I have a son and I can't imagine not being able to go for a walk with him, or play with him after school. Daniel's continuing therapy, including transportation, is going to cost about \$60 a month. Will you pray about helping Daniel with this expense? Daniel and Daniel Jr. are good soil, worth the investment.



Please pray for our 4 summer interns as they are helping us with the 9 groups that we have between now and the end of summer. We are also advancing our missions trip devotional that will be released by the end of the summer. Please keep that in your prayers as we try to help more people advance the kingdom together.
